Annual Cake Bake Contest Rules:

- 1) All cakes entered must be baked and decorated by the scout and a parent.
- 2) No pre-baked cakes. Cakes must be created from box mixes or scratch. No more than two cake mix boxes can be used on one cake.
- 3) All ingredients and decorations and presentation accessories must be edible (they don't have to taste good!). No wooden support dowels, wedding cake fountains, LED lights, dry ice, wires or other non edible decorations or cake supporting items. (The baseboard the cakes sits on does not need to be edible)
- 4) Cakes can be created in varying shapes and sizes but all cakes cannot exceed either 9" round or 9" * 15" rectangular maximum displacement/footprint. No restrictions on the height of the cake.
- 5) Cakes can be entered in any of the following three categories for judging:
 - i. National Monuments
 - ii. Turn back the Clock
 - iii. The Great Outdoors
- 6) The decision of the judges will be final. Cakes will be judged for originality, creativity and artistic presentation.
- 7) All cakes entering the contest are to be delivered to the site of the Blue and Gold between 5-5:30 on 26 February 2011 and placed on the pre-determined table by judging category. Tables will be marked with category. Scout determines category his cake will compete in.
- 8) Cakes will be judged by a panel of 4 judges. First, Second and Third place ribbons will be awarded in each cake category
